Baptism:

Matrimony:

Religious Article Sale:

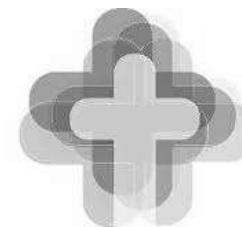

Una Palabra del Pastor

Las Virtudes Cardinales

Vivir en un mundo que parece estar lleno de vicios o hábitos que nos llevan a pecar, pensé que sería bueno para nosotros enfocarnos esta semana en algunas de las cosas que conducen a la bondad, la santidad y la rectitud: las cuatro virtudes cardinales. La justicia, la prudencia, la templanza y la fortaleza se consideran comúnmente como las virtudes cardinales. Primero provocado por los filósofos Platón y Aristóteles, estas cuatro virtudes cardinales, o bisagras, fueron adoptadas más tarde por los padres de la Iglesia como fundamento para vivir una vida virtuosa que aleja del pecado.

Cada una de las cuatro virtudes depende de que las demás sean completas, por lo tanto, son bisagras del estilo de vida cristiano. Cada una de las virtudes tiene significados y entendimientos tanto religiosos como seculares, y cada una de las virtudes es difícil de alcanzar en su plenitud también.

San Agustín continuará a explicarlos en términos con respecto a Dios y su amor simplemente como, "Por estas cuatro virtudes (;todos sentirían su influencia en sus mentes ya que tienen sus nombres en la boca!), No debería dudar en definirlos: esa templanza es el amor que se entrega completamente a lo que es amores; la fortaleza es el amor que soporta todas las cosas por el bien del objeto amado; la justicia es amor sirviendo solo al objeto amado, y por lo tanto gobernando correctamente; la prudencia es el amor que distingue con sagacidad entre lo que lo obstaculiza y lo que lo ayuda. . (*De moribus eccl.*, Chap XV)."

Entonces, como podemos ver, lo que he estado predicando, realmente desde que me convertí en pastor, es realmente el uso de la integración del amor de Dios basado en las Virtudes Cardinales, y cómo podemos aplicarlos mejor a nuestro estado de ser. Entonces, la próxima vez que estés luchando con el pecado, pregúntate si te falta alguna de estas virtudes, y ve a dónde Dios te está llamando para ser más virtuoso.

A Word from the Pastor

The Cardinal Virtues

Living in a world that seems to be filled with vices, or habits that lead us to sin, I thought I would be good for us to focus this week on some of the things that lead to goodness, holiness, and righteousness: that being the four Cardinal Virtues. Justice, Prudence, Temperance, and Fortitude, are commonly held as the Cardinal Virtues. First brought about by the philosophers Plato and Aristotle, these four cardinal, or hinge, virtues were later adopted by the Church fathers as foundational to living a life of virtue leading away from sin.

Each of the four virtues relies on the others to be complete, thus they are hinges to the Christian way of life. Each of the virtues have both religious as well as secular meanings and understandings, and each of the virtues is hard to attain in its fullness as well.

St Augustine would go on to explain them in terms regarding God and His love simply as, "For these four virtues (would that all felt their influence in their minds as they have their names in their mouths!), I should have no hesitation in defining them: that temperance is love giving itself entirely to that which is loves; fortitude is love readily bearing all things for the sake of the loved object; justice is love serving only the loved object, and therefore ruling rightly; prudence is love distinguishing with sagacity between what hinders it and what helps it. (*De moribus eccl.*, Chap XV)."

So, as we can see, what I have been preaching about, really since becoming pastor, is really the use of the integration of God's love based on the Cardinal Virtues, and how we can better apply them to our state of being. So the next time that you are struggling with sin, ask yourself if you may be lacking in any of these virtues, and see where God is calling you to be more virtuous.
