Baptism:

To schedule classes for parents and Godparents of children under age 8, please contact Fr Danny or Deacon Rich.

For those ages 8 and older desiring the sacrament of Baptism, please contact Fran Thibodeau to arrange classes.

First Communion:

Two years of preparation are required for First Communion and First Reconciliation. The minimum age for reception of these sacraments is 7, or second grade. Please contact Fran Thibodeau for more information.

Confirmation:

Two years of preparation are required for Confirmation, beginning the freshman year of high school at the earliest. Please contact Fran Thibodeau for more information.

Matrimony:

Six months' preparation are required for the sacrament of Matrimony. Please contact Fr Danny or Deacon Rich for more information.

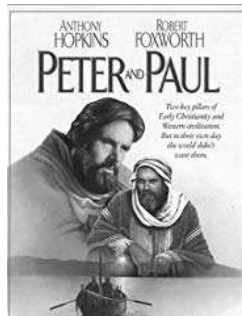
